Guidelines for Dr Shibendu Shankar Ray's Best Doctoral Thesis Award of the Indian Society of Agrophysics, New Delhi

- Award will be bestowed to one PhD thesis covering research in subject areas of Agricultural Physics
 / Soil Physics / Plant Biophysics / Agricultural Remote Sensing / Agricultural Meteorology only and
 accepted for PhD Degree
- The university awarding degree shall be UGC recognized Indian university
- The applicant need not be a member (annual/life) of the ISAP
- The thesis should be in partial or total fulfillment for the award of PhD degree
- The title of the award shall be **Dr Shibendu Shankar Ray's Best Doctoral Thesis Award for the years 2022–2023**
- It is an annual award one per year.
- A thesis **accepted** during one year starting from 1 July of a calendar year to 30 June of the next succeeding year will be eligible. The date of successfully passing the final thesis viva-voce will be taken for deciding the academic year. (e.g. for the 2022–23 year award, thesis accepted between 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023)
- The award will consist of a Medal and citation and it will be presented to the awardee during any major function (Annual Symposium / Dr B.P. Ghildiyal Lecture/etc.) of the Society in the inaugural session. The symposium registration fee (if any) for the awardee will be waived-off for attending the function. The awardee needs to make his own arrangements for attending the function.
- The expenses towards the award will be met from the interest earned from the corpus fund donated by the family for the award
- The secretary in consultation with EC will widely circulate the notice for the award in the month of
 July of every year and give two months of the time period for the submission of applications as per
 the FORMAT of application along with a soft and hard copy of the doctoral thesis and other evidences.
- The awardee will be declared in the month of December of the succeeding year.
- The applicant needs to submit the softcopy of the application on or before the due date in the attached format with a copy of the thesis, PDC/Degree, Marksheet/Transcript, and other required evidences. A hard copy of the thesis shall also be submitted. Applications received after the due date and/or incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.
- The application shall be evaluated by a FOUR-member committee duly constituted by the EC. One member shall be from the serving faculty of the Agricultural Physics discipline of ICAR-IARI. The committee shall screen the applications received in proper format and with all required documents for selecting the five best theses for presentation and final decision. The applicant shall be invited to make a presentation before the Evaluation committee.
- The total marks for evaluation will be 100. The Evaluation Committee will award marks out of 50 based on their evaluation through the presentation, 10 marks will be based on the OGPA of PhD and the remaining 40 marks will be based on the best thesis evaluation proforma. The award will be given to the applicant securing the highest marks.
